³ This assumes double occupancy using the most comprehensive meal plan.

⁴ This is an estimate of the cost of room and board to live in the community in which the school is located.

The tuition, fees, room and board costs listed above are not your total cost to attend a college, technical institute, or other higher education training. Remember that you will have expenses for transportation, clothing, personal supplies, and other living expenses.
